St Michael the Archangel – East Teignmouth Treasurer's Report 2023

Copies of the annual accounts are available to view online. If you require a hard copy, please send a request to Christine Vince. They have been independently examined by Mr John Thomasson FIIA.

The total receipts from unrestricted funds were £71950. Sums totalling £8174 were received for specific funds including; the Team PCCs towards the costs of administrative services, interest restricted to the Flower and Fabric Funds and a legacy of £2000 received under our legacy policy. Agency funds for distribution to various charities and fees for dispersal following weddings and Funerals amounted to £5647.50.

We were able to pay 90% of our Common Fund £46,113, with a £5,000 shortfall. We continue find making our contribution challenging. Our problems with the heating system in the late months of the year have curtailed our ability to hire the premises for events. We have not yet fully recovered from the impacts of COVID and our service time change leaving some of our parishioners reluctant to participate in regular worship. Sadly, we have lost several generous givers to the stewardship schemes in 2022. Our Common Fund set for 2023 is £53690, an increase of £2577, this amounts to more than £1000 each week.

During the year our stewardship schemes remained relatively well supported. At the end of 2022, 30 people were stewarding regularly through the Parish Giving Scheme, 8 by monthly Standing Order to the bank and 12 via the weekly envelope scheme. The amount raised through stewardship was just £973 more than 2021. The giving patterns have continued to change post pandemic, yellow envelope giving is still £1087 less than 2019 however cash collections have increased.

The Revd. Carol committed to supporting a Stewardship Campaign that included an inclusion of teaching on Stewardship during our weekly communion, a mail out to all our church members giving illustrations of where our money goes and an invitation to reflect on our levels of giving, included were forms to access the various ways we can give. This resulted in some encouraging responses which were particularly well received following the loss of so many of our regular supporters in the last twelve months.

We received two generous donations on our Gift Day which amounted to £3000, along with other contributions of £363. It may be that our Gift Day would be better received at Michaelmas to coincide with our Patronal Festival and harvest celebrations? We received a generous gift of £650 to pay for the cost of investigating the source pf the leak to our heating system.

Our regular fundraising activities; the Plant Sale, Flower Festival and Christmas Fair all took place this year. All took more in receipts than in 2019 and this should be celebrated. We were glad to see the return of the Mens Breakfast. The receipts from the Sunday Roasts and our enthusiastic Craft Club have been welcome. It is good see other fundraising activities return and the formation of a new Social Committee is also a welcome reintroduction.

The number of funerals and weddings were less than pre pandemic levels (income down by £900 on 2019). With increased footfall in the church, the donations via the wall safe and the pillar more than doubled this year.

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We received the £2000 legacy from Joan Randall. As per our Legacy Policy the funds were spent on fabric items, principally the upgrading of electrical works identified in the five-yearly service report. To be able to leave a legacy to our church is such a gift and privilege, it is a wonderful way to support our church family and to continue to share the message of Christ's love for us into the future. If you have reason to make or update your will this year, please consider including some provision for the upkeep and mission of St Michael's.

Charitable giving in 2022 consisted of the Christingle collection to The Children's Society £251, a retiring collection for the people of Ukraine £259, participation in the Devon Historic Churches Trust Ride and Stride Day which raised £253 and finally at a Patronal Festival held in Bitton House £147.50 was raised for The Teignmouth Community Larder (with grateful thanks to the generosity of the caterers).

We have had a few exceptional expenses to contend with this year, a review of our wiring in the church and the inspection and subsequent remedial works cost £3350. Our heating system developed a leak excess water charges amounting to £700. The cost to investigate the leak to date is £839. Costs of hiring temporary methods of heating to date amounted to £932. However, we are currently only paying a standing charge for the gas and our electricity charges remain very high. The church is fortunate to have a fixed contract for electricity up to 28th February 2023 and gas until March 2023. The Diocese issued a grant of £890 towards our energy costs in December 2022.

We are looking at another financially challenging year, I would like to thank you for all your prayers, encouragement and support as I continue serving as your treasurer to the PCC.
